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CRIMES / INCIDENTS

Crimes recorded between 01/04/2026 and 27/01/2026.

A total of 36 crimes were recorded on the West Fife and Coastal Villages area in the time frame detailed above.

The crimes have been grouped into police subdivisions (details below) to allow us to provide some detail whilst preserving confidentiality.

1A – There were 4 crimes recorded including A Dog Dangerously Out of Control, Damage to a Property and a Domestic crime.

1B – There were 20 crimes recorded including Road Traffic Offences, numerous assaults, Domestic crimes and thefts from a rural location.

1C – There were 12 crimes recorded during this period of time including Road Traffic Offences, assaults, Domestic offences and Vandalisms

Reviewing the crimes for this month, one incident of note relates to several thefts which occurred from a rural property in the Oakley area. Enquiries are ongoing into these offences.

1A – Torryburn, Newmills, High Valleyfield, Culross and Kincardine

1B – Carnock, Gowkhall, Oakley, Comrie, Blairhall, Saline and Steelend

1C – Pattiesmuir, Limekilns, Charlestown, Crombie and Cairneyhill

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COMMUNITY WARD UPDATE

In the last month PCs Cooper and Patience have been on patrol in the Ward 1 area and have attended local events including patrols in relation to the Two Bridges Ultramarathon that passed through the area on Saturday 25th April and the Culross community market on Sunday 26th April.

PCs Cooper and Patience also attended at Carnock Primary School within the last month, accompanied by PS Bell and spoke to P1/2/3 about the role of police officers.

Specific concerns were raised at the most recent meeting of Saline and Steelend Community Council, however PCs Cooper and Patience were unable to attend. As a result a meeting was arranged between the CPT and members of the Community Council to allow a discussion in relation to the issues highlighted at the CC meeting.

Speeding is regularly raised as an issue in the Ward 1 area. PCs Cooper and Patience have managed to deploy on several occasions to hotspot areas identified by the local communities, including Saline and Cairneyhill (pictured below).



Where relevant, concerns over speeding in certain areas has been passed on to the Road Policing Team and the Safety Camera Partnership team for their information and action.
