MATTERS ARISING FROM PREVIOUS MINUTES;

POLICE REPORT:

Information was circulated by R D. Police carried out speed checks at Drumoig at specific check points

SR commented on fact that Guardbridge Community Council were monitoring speed at Guardbridge .There had been no prosecutions but 180 letters were sent to those caught speeding.

Volunteers from Drumoig have offered to continue with speed monitoring but the community and the Police have reservations about the safety of those taking part. Cllr Louise KD has a meeting with Gavin Kay, North East Fife Community Rep and an invitation for further discussion with PC Dawn Dohery was suggested.

The Community Council wish to take this matter further with a meeting.

There have been several complaints to the police about speeding in the Wormit area also. It was noted that the Leuchars community were disappointed with the lack of liaison with the Army and this did not compare favourably with that of the RAF. Cllr Louise KD noted that the new division's presence had caused some upheaval to programmes in the school. No mention had been made of any planned VE DAY celebrations either in Leuchars or the other surrounding communities.
