

Banner hot spots

You can create invisible circles on you banner that are actually links and can be clicked. Typically these may include links to social media sites where the logos (Twitter etc.) are embedded in the banner.

Here is a banner:



The top left coordinate is $X = 0, Y = 0$

The bottom right coordinate is $X = 960, Y = 100$

You can add a hot spot in the middle of the grey area to the right of the words as follows:

Classification:	<input type="text" value="Link to BBC website"/>				
Introductory text:	<input type="text" value="http://www.bbc.co.uk"/>				
Coordinates: X:	<input type="text" value="300"/>	Y:	<input type="text" value="50"/>	Radius:	<input type="text" value="20"/>

You can then add as many hot spots as you wish. Remember though to modify your banner accordingly otherwise people won't know where to click!
