Privacy & Data Protection Policy

Digital Fife recognises the importance of your privacy and complies with all relevant privacy and data protection legislation.

Personal Information

Digital Fife does not record the private information of website visitors.

The form used to contact us does not store your personal information. It simply generates an email containing your email address and message.

Should we require your personal information to allow us to contact you, you should complete the data protection form to provide permission for us to record and process your personal information. If you wish to change any of your contact preferences, you may contact us at any time via either the contact page on this website or resubmit the data protection form.

You may request a copy of any personal information we hold about you, and we will respond within 28 days. You may also request that any personal information is deleted.

Cookies

Cookies are small text files placed on a user's device by websites to remember information, such as login status and browsing preferences.

The cookies created directly by this website (first-party cookies) are classified as “essential” and only contain information that help you to use the Digital Fife website, such as accessibility settings. Essential cookies are permitted under the Privacy and Electronic Communications Regulations (PECR) and UK General Data Protection Regulations (UK GDPR).

This site also makes use of embedded third-party software which may generate its own cookies that might include tracking information and advertising. For this reason, website visitors are required to provide explicit permission to access this third-party content. Where this permission is not given, the third-party functionality is disabled, and the cookies are not created.

The cookies created by this website are classed as non-persistent, meaning that they are only active for the current browser session. As soon as you close your browser or re-start your device, the cookie will be deleted.

Digital Fife does not have access to any information stored within the cookies that may have been created by other sites you have visited.
